Writer, poet and film director, Pier Paolo Pasolini, a controversial character for his unconventional and often contradictory positions, has left an important legacy to Italian culture, with his work both marking his time and standing as a prophecy of what society would become.

The artists tackle in this exhibition the themes of Pasolini's thought, expressed in the different choices of Pasolini's artistic language, to interpret and shape reality.

Six Italian artists and two artists from the Netherlands, who lived in Italy for a long time, will feature in this exhibition, that will be located in the prestigious spaces of the Pulchri Studio in The Hague from the 30th of July to the 14th of August 2022.
